Already eight years in Romania

After almost 8 years in Romania, we are still full steam ahead, and the operation itself continues to grow and prosper. At the center in Geoagiu, the programs are running at full speed.

Homework club

Here the children are supervised twice a week after school. We help them with their homework and, if necessary, give them some extra work/ tutoring to bring them up to the required educational level. But very important is to keep motivating and encouraging them to keep going to school. Because of their backwardness and the prevailing discrimination, this is very often a huge task for them.





A fresh, hot meal for the children

On Tuesdays and Thursdays, when children attend homework club, the children are offered a hot or cold meal at the centre during the break.



Childeren's program

On Fridays we have the children's program: still we remain committed to this as well. It is so important to teach the children in this way, in a playful way, to teach them values and norms, to love them and treat them with respect so that they can discover their own value and sometimes just let the children be children. Enjoying being creative and allowing their abilities to emerge.





Mothers & toddlers

With the help of creative programs, the young moms learn a lot. Often the teen moms are not aware of anything and barely know what and how to do with their little ones. It's also a way for the little ones and the moms to learn to let go of each other a bit in a pleasant and loving atmosphere. And at the same time, the little ones are prepared for kindergarten during the programs.





Elderly group

The elderly also get their turn and enjoy to the fullest sometimes very simple crafts. But especially the loving attention, the listening ear and the cup of coffee with a cookie is worth gold to them.



The youth is also getting more and more attention: starting with soccer games to build a deeper relationship with them as well. And once we have more space in the center, we want to invest more time in them there as well. We really see that relationships can change a lot.







Helping where we can

The material help is also still going on, perhaps to a lesser extent because of the high costs of the center, but where the need is biggest, we are still ready to do whatever we can. So we are still giving out stoves, making and distributing food parcels, renewing roofs, giving out doors and windows... But also helping people with clothes and handing out kitchen utensils, for example, is still being organized in the center between programs. Also in the Roma village of Orastie we try to meet the highest needs as often as possible.







Started in faith

Reconstruction work on the centre also started again. A ring beam urgently needs to be made on the centre so that the necessary walls can be built as well as covering what still needs to be covered. In the office and kitchen, we already have some water damage. And once it starts freezing it will only get more difficult.

In addition, the work at home continues. No no, not for ourselves, but soon we already have some groups planned for which sleeping accommodation still needs to be created. The sanitary area for these groups also needs to be seriously tackled. With leftover material from the renovations of the barn, we try to do what we can and furthermore we pray for the other necessary budgets. We believe that everything will be fine. We can only keep going lol.





Roma boots for our Roma kids

So after a long wait and many attempts Jessica finally managed to get the Americans here with their fantastic Roma boots. A wonderful initiative in which a Roma named Samuel comes from America to Romania every year to provide probably a thousand children with good sturdy boots. They did this not only for Pe lunca, but also for many other humanitarian organizations throughout Romania.

We are so grateful for this, because believe me, the children here need sturdy and warm shoes more than bit. What a blessing!

Christmas preparations

As we approach Christmas, we are also busy preparing for it. Soon we will receive again very gratefully numerous shoe boxes. The AmenTrust team will also be present again in order to be a blessing to many children and families.

Jessica and Bavo are working with Dinah and Simona on a Christmas event that will take place at the center. But not Jessica, Dinah and Simona alone, no no, especially the children are going to prepare themselves to entertain all the mommies, daddies, grandmothers and grandfathers to share with them what Christmas is all about.
