What they make we will try to sell, probably when we come to Belgium, or we see which doors will open up for this.

One thing is already very clear, the women enjoy it to the fullest and really do their very best.

Being away from their misery, feeling worthy and appreciated, having a nice chat with a cup of coffee and they can even earn some money with it. And eventually what they make is really worth it.

There is only one problem, soon the room will be way to small and sewing machines will be too short because enthusiastic moms are added every time

Last weekend we went to visit an American couple (Jacob and Cami) who, together with their six children, are also missionaries here in Romania. We are very, very grateful for these people. Not only are they willing to help us when we might need them, but above all because it clicked so well between us and we certainly have new friends in the area. Jacob had arranged three places for me (Tijs) to speak, once for a youth group, on Sunday morning church service, and Sunday evening on an evangelization. It was a privilege to be there to encourage so many people.

Meanwhile we still have a lot of paperwork. To get officially accredited in Geoagiu we still have to keep climbing to get over that mountain of paperwork. Also to be able to hire a social worker some paperwork has to be done and even our volunteers still need to have volunteer contracts. Then we still have the bookkeeping, which is getting bigger and bigger every year, but it's finally in its final stage. At the beginning of March we'll bring it to Tirgu-Mures.

The good news is that Alina will take over the bookkeeping from us as of this year. Alina has been working for us voluntarily for a long time. She sorts and makes parcels in the barn, helps with the sewing project and now she will also take care of the bookkeeping. And all this voluntarily! What a blessing!





General budget

I would also like to mention in this newsletter that due to the growth of the organisation, more and more people are starting to support us more specifically. E.g. purely for children's work, or building and renovating, food, families, child adoption, etc. This is simply fantastic, but it does mean that people donate less for our general budget. This general budget is also crucial for further growth. Not only the general costs of the organization are paid for from this, but also the workmen for e.g. building and renovating houses, working on and around the center, ... When all the papers are in order, we could soon start to further expand and build on our domain in Geoagiu. These works are required by the government to be allowed to do what we do there. For this we are going to need at least five workmen. Also the social worker that we are obliged to hire, and urgently need, will have to be paid from this budget.

With this I want to bring it to your attention again, because if you don't know the needs, it's also difficult to respond to them. So if there are people who have it in their heart to contribute to this, please always mention 'General budgets' specifically. Thank you so much!
