What if we start breeding ourselves?

A big job, but in the long run a lot cheaper. Our hearts caught fire and we immediately took the cow by the horns. At the same time we were very encouraged with a new contact that 'coincidentally' came our way. During the lockdown our friend Pete was stuck in England and got to know someone called Colin. They got to talking and it turned out that Colin provides a lot of poor people with food through his own cultivation, very interesting man! Pete told Colin about us (ignorant about our new plans) and Colin was immediately very impressed and wanted to contact us with the proposal to start breeding ourselves.

In the meantime we called each other several times now, always very encouraging, but also very instructive as he has a lot of experience in this field. So in the meantime, a few months later, we already have about thirty chickens to breed, fifteen giant rabbits, seven ducks and our first fresh vegetables. So we didn't sit still during the lockdown, but started building cages and boxes for our animals. We still have a lot of work to do before everything will be ready. At the moment the rabbits are still in small pens and also for the ducks there needs to be a better facility, but step by step everything will be fine. Also a small storage room for maintenance supplies, pet food and hay has yet to be made. We are already grateful for the helping hands of our kids.



So this is our newest project which we are very excited about. The intention is that, for example, with time, people will get a couple of rabbits to breed from there selves. Of course, that is easier said than done, because there is still a whole process involved. People are simply not used to thinking ahead at all. So before we get them to take good care of the animals, and not to eat them all at once, ...

But in the meantime we have achieved so much with them that we are firmly convinced that this project will not miss its goal either. Of course, this is not the only thing we have done in the past weeks/ months. We continued with our homework club. Well, homework was transformed into teaching. Every child gets individual worksheets and also learns and plays with the letters of the alphabet. In the beginning we almost had to drag some of the children to the center and we had to insist on getting there on time. Now we arrive at the center and the children are already waiting for us. Isn't that just fantastic!

In the meantime, of course, it became a bit more difficult to organize everything properly because of the measures. But the children have their own masks. So we continue! We hope they will be well prepared for the start of the new school year. If the children will be a bit more up to level, this will cause one less reason for discrimination anyway. Then just before school starts we will provide each of them with decent clothes, shoes, the necessary school materials and of course we will be ready for them after school to continue working.

At the beginning of the summer we took a short break ourselves. We went to the sea in Romania, enjoying with our kids. Normally we have visitors month after month and now this was not possible anymore because of corona. We have missed our family and friends the last few months, but on the other hand we could enjoy our family alone for a while. Where are we now with the center 'Inima Lui'?

As far as the expansion of the center is concerned, all papers are almost complete. This means that we can start demolishing and building up. The main building will of course remain, but we will have to build a sanitary block there. On the other side of our property there the metal roof has to be completely demolished and rebuilt. All this is necessary to be in line with legislation, to be able to continue doing what we are doing, and what we still have in mind. It goes without saying that all of this goes hand in hand with a huge cost. Paperwork alone costs 6300€! This is all money we don't have yet, but we believe it will arrive when God wants it.

We don't really know yet how we will do the work. With a company it will be extra expensive, and with our local workers it will take a whole lot longer and it will also bring a lot more work for us. The last thing we thought of was construction teams. It would be great if we could get some construction teams to help us with this and thus help to further develop our project. We see, we think and pray further and are already convinced that everything will become clear in time.

Now, I'm going to stop typing, I still have to feed all the animals (because it's already 9am, so I'm already late) and then back to the tablet to continue this newsletter.
