The children are so happy that the programs can continue again. When we had the first program again the children were already waiting at the gate from 11 am while the program only started at 1:30 pm. You can imagine that they were super quiet once the gate opened.

Not!! After a year and a half without programs and then waiting impatiently for hours, about 70 children entered the domain. Immediately footballs shot through the air on all sides and there was a great bustle. But above all fun and happy faces. It's quite a job to get such an over-enthusiastic group of children to listen, but Jessica and Alex are just perfect for the job. All children nicely together against the wall of the building, finger on the mouth and other hand in the air until everyone is quiet. And then sing a song or three or four along with the necessary gestures and the guitar. After the singing, they pray together for a while, then they are much calmer, are divided into groups and the activities are started. What a pleasure!

Now we all go to the building in Geoagiu. It only takes ten minutes by car to get there.

Here the construction is still on hold. Again something appeared to be wrong with the paperwork and to get this right we needed an intermediary. We were recommended someone from the town hall in Geoagiu who took on our entire file and promised to get it done in no more than two weeks. During the past four months we called him about 100 times and we could hardly get him on the phone, so our hands were tied. Finally we found out where he lives and paid him a polite visit. No, this is not like Belgium where everyone has their own office. You have to know where they live. But so we had all our papers back and in the meantime our dear volunteer Simona had already spoken to someone else. Fortunately, this person is now from good soil and immediately he took the cow by its horns. So hopefully everything will be in order soon and we can get started.

## **Fashion-session**

No more looking where to build, we turn around and take a step towards the building. Here especially Jessica and Bavo, together with volunteer Alina, have been immersing themselves in clothing for a few weeks now. Quite a job since we don't have any other rooms for this in Geoagiu. Everything happens in the main hall and has to be moved in and out of the boxes. Talking about staying busy huh. Quite diffi cult, but at the moment there is no other way. All the clothes were sorted and distributed on the tables so that people can come and choose what they need. First it was the adult clothes, now the children's clothes. We always let the people in by five, so everything could go relatively quietly and there could also be help with them to find the right sizes.

But also the homework programs continued here, so by then everything has to be in the boxes again so that the children have enough space to work.

We were really looking forward to this week (the week of July 5). We finally welcomed back the group from America, which under normal circumstances comes every year. Together with them, and our many translators, we will be working very intensely for another full week with the children of both Geoagiu and Romos. This promises to be another enormously beautiful and blessed week.
