Bavo also helped very diligently with construction work. And at the home base, Annelies and Salina took care of meals and laundry for the hard workers. After these two weeks, "Stichting in de vrijheid" decided that they would return again with another team at the end of September.

## Childrens camp in the mountains

It was a very pleasant cooperation.

Each one of this Scottish team had taken the initiative to set up a fundraise. Someone climbed the highest mountains in Scotland, someone else rode a bicycle from one side of the country to the other, performances were organized,...

Thanks to their efforts we did not have to worry about the financial part. Even better, we also received a very nice donation for the camp from the children's club of the evangelical church De Hoeksteen from Belgium. We were able to pay for the transportation of the children and purchase materials we needed for the camp. There was even some left over. We keep this especially for working with these kids.

And this camp got a very nice conclusion. Also the team from Scotland enjoyed the cooperation enormously, so they decided together that they wanted a partnership with us. This means that from now on 'Carpathian Aid' will send a team every year to help us and will also look to fund this camp every year. What a blessing!!!
