She told us that every document we needed had to pass through her hands, but she already gave her blessing and promised to approve everything immediately. And apparently that happened, because in no time at all we received the message that the entire accreditation file had been approved.

On to the license. The accreditation was just step one, a small step compared to what follows, but it was a very intense and very important step. We received the finances for this project this summer from Carpathian Aid from Scotland. This will allow us to pay the social worker for all the work she had on it. Praise the Lord.
