Jacob and Cami have their own ministry about an hour's drive from us, but they thought it would be a great idea to bless us with the teams they received. Amazing, right? The women helped with the center activities and sorting clothes, while the men rolled up their sleeves to move heavy items and store furniture at the place where we host our youth ministry. On top of that, we had a wonderful time of fellowship that was truly encouraging for all of us.
